The program also honored

two recipients of the 5th Annual Mike Corbett Memorial Safety Award, which recognizes a union craftworker or company employee who has shown an exemplary commitment or random act of safety that has made them a standout for their efforts.

The 5th Annual Mike Corbett Memorial Safety Award is named in memory of Mike Corbett, a Compliance Assistance Specialist for OSHA Region II, who was widely respected for sharing his extensive safety expertise with the construction industry and for his kindness, compassion, and steadfast dedication to protecting workers.

This award is typically given to one person, but this year two individuals, Mike Stevenson and Phil Radomski Jr., were recognized for their outstanding safety efforts:

- **Mike Stevenson**, Project Superintendent for HC Constructors, Inc., is a 20-year member of Laborers Local 472 and a 14-year employee of HC Constructors. Mike was recognized for his selfless actions after a car flipped and caught fire outside the Merck jobsite in Rahway. He rushed to pull the driver to safety. Every day, Mike leads by example, setting high standards for safety while always putting people and family first.
- **Phil Radomski Jr.**, Director of Safety for Frank V. Radomski & Sons, Inc., views safety as a commitment to protecting people. With a B.S. in Occupational Safety & Environmental Health and numerous certifications, including his CSP designation, he has dedicated his career to advancing workplace safety. Through innovative training programs, safety videos, and his leadership, Phil continues to make a lasting impact across the industry.
